This is the motto for the '7<sup>th</sup> Lech Classic Festival 2018' from 31<sup>st</sup> July until 4<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

On five consecutive days music and nature will be harmonized among the grandiose mountain backdrop of the Arlberg Mountain. The international winter sports resort Lech has also in the summertime an attraction worth visiting.

All concert are 'gala events' and are therefore a sequence of masterpieces of mainly classic and romantic music literature.

In 2018 there are the following theme nights:

- 'Slavic Night' (i.e. F. Smetana 'Die Moldau', A. Dvorak: cello concert)
- 'French Melodies' (vocal and instrumental highlights of the French Romanticism)
- 'Incomplete – complete' (incomplete masterpieces by Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert)
- 'Musical valuables' (i.e. Vivaldi 'Four Seasons', Mozart: piano concert no. 27)

Outstanding international soloists will be accompanied by the 'Lech Festival Orchestra', a body of sound performing on an international high level. Audience, orchestra and soloists melt into an intimate unit which creates a distinctive concert experience.

This summer festival has established itself very quickly within the European festival scene. Atmosphere and quality turn your visit to the festival into a special experience.
